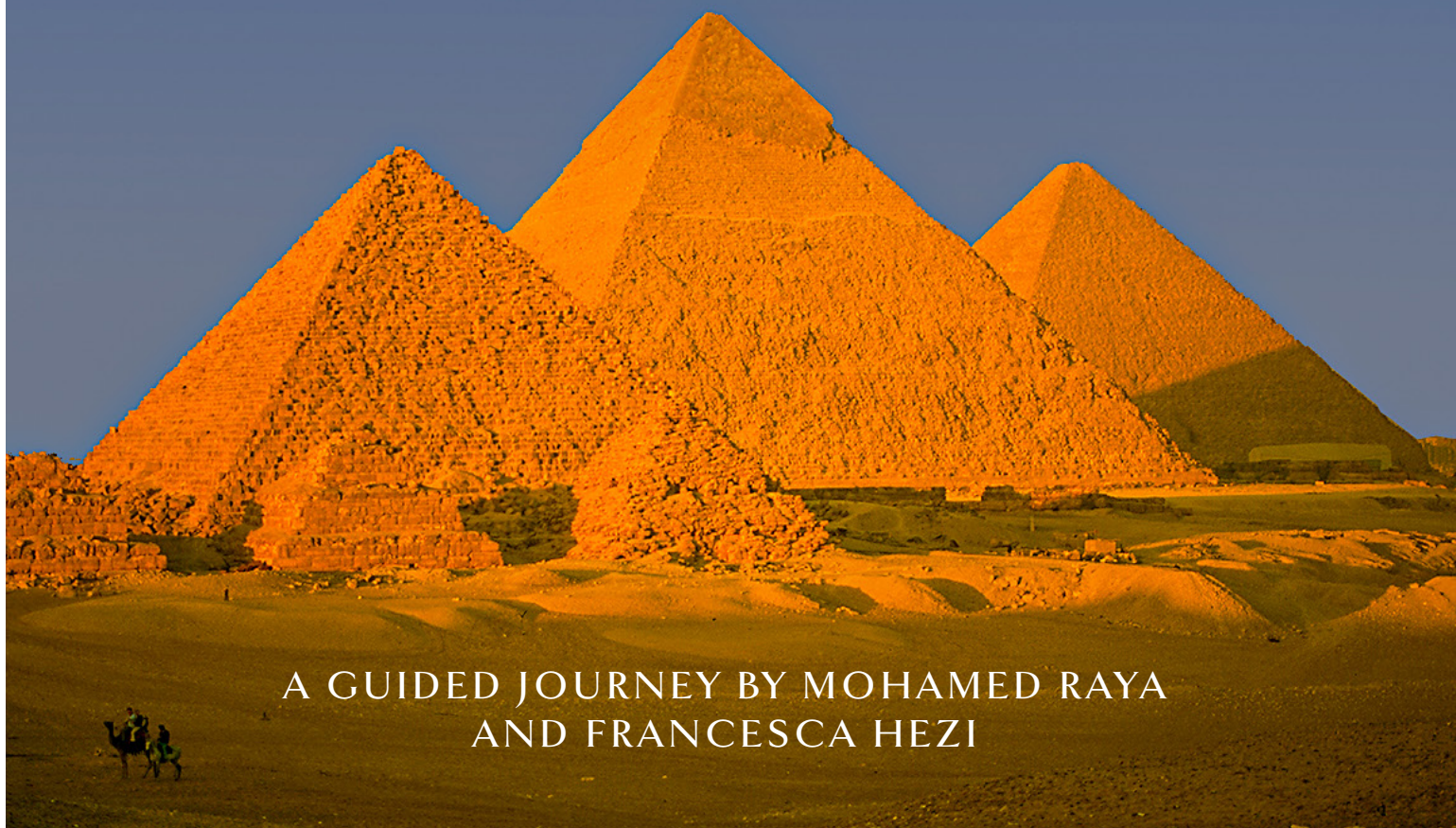

YOUR ITINERARY

DAY 1 [OCTOBER 10]

You'll be met and assisted by our representative at Cairo International Airport, who will help you get your entry visa upon arrival and then escort you by private vehicle to the Marriott Omar Khayam or Hyatt Regency Hotel in Cairo.

DAY 2 [OCTOBER 11—MORNING]

In our private vehicle, we will drive south to the most ancient step pyramid at Saqqara and the complex of the Pharaoh Djoser. Aligned with Thoth, the enlightened communicator, holy scribe and “architect of wisdom”—Saqqara opens a portal to channel our highest personal truth. We'll break for lunch at a local restaurant.

DAY 2 [OCTOBER 11—AFTERNOON]

After lunch, we'll visit the most famous pyramids of Giza, entering the Great Pyramid and burial chamber of Pharaoh Khufu, with its very powerful crown chakra energy, enabling us to love and serve all. Our last stop of the day will be the incomparable Sphinx—third eye of awareness and sacred alter of the god of silence. We can arrange a private opening of the Great Pyramid and Sphinx instead of our daytime visit. We'll stay over night at the Marriott Omar Khayam or Hyatt Regency Hotel in Cairo. [B,L,D]

DAY 3 [OCTOBER 12]

After an early breakfast, we'll make the four-hour drive south along the Nile River to the archeological site of Tell el-Amarna on the east bank, location of Pharaoh Akhenaten and Queen Nefertiti's sacred city of Akhetaten, where the voice of love emanates from the throat chakra. We will explore the excavation of the royal palaces on the plain and the tombs located in the hills beyond. That evening, we'll celebrate our expressions of unconditional love with voice and words, then stay overnight at the Grand Aton Hotel in Minya on the west bank of the Nile. [B,D]

DAY 4 | OCTOBER 13 |

After breakfast in Minya, we will drive to Abydos to visit the mortuary temple of Pharaoh Seti I, and his cenotaph, the Osirion, where we'll have time for silence and contemplation about death and resurrection. Reborn, we'll journey to meet the Goddess Hathor—"Lady of the Milky Way"—at the Temple of Dendera, where we are invited to recognize ourselves as containers of love, forgiveness, and compassion. We'll continue on to Luxor and spend the night at Steigenberger Resort or Sonestra St. George Hotel. [B,D]

DAY 5 | OCTOBER 14 |

We'll get an early morning start to visit the temples at Karnak with its sanctuary of the heart chakra, balancing the illumination in our souls and ridding ourselves of disorder as we visit the shrine of Goddess Sekhmet. This initiation connects us to an esoteric web of consciousness, higher dimensions of power, magic, and self-healing. Then, on to the Luxor Temple, dedicated to Amun-Ra, with sacred geometry that will assist in opening our energy centers and channel healing frequencies through our entire being. We'll spend the night at the Steigenberger Resort or Sonestra St. George Hotel. [B,L,D]

DAY 6 [OCTOBER 15]

Another early start, with an optional hot air Balloon flight over the west bank of the Nile at sunrise. We'll visit the Valley of the Kings and the most colorful tombs of the pharaohs—including Tutankhamun—giving us time to meditate upon incarnation and resurrection, then Deir el-Bahari and the magnificent mortuary temple of the most famous female pharaoh, Hatshepsut. We'll gather for a session of forgiveness with totally open hearts to prepare ourselves for receiving and exchanging the upcoming energy, then retire to our hotel in Luxor at the Steigenberger Resort or Sonestra St. George Hotel. [B,L,D]

DAY 7 [OCTOBER 16]

After breakfast, we'll drive to Edfu to visit its famous temple of the falcon god, Horus. At this temple, an analog of the solar plexus chakra, we can feel the wisdom and power of the warrior god. We'll continue on to Kom-Ombo Temple for a visit with the crocodile god, Sobek, and Haroeris—Horus the Elder. For us, this temple symbolizes the creativity inherent in the naval chakra. After an early dinner, we will have an opportunity to learn about sacred oils and incense used to open each of the chakras, and then spend a relaxing night at the Mövenpick Aswan Resort. [B,D]

DAY 8 [OCTOBER 17]

We'll have breakfast in Aswan, then visit the Greco-Roman Temple of Philae, the only Egyptian temple built on an island—and moved to another when the Aswan Dam was constructed. Here, in one of the burial places of Osiris, we will align from our crown to our root chakras, open to our divine feminine and masculine power with the help of the goddess Isis, and her husband Osiris, receive blessings, and exchange our energy with each other. We'll take time to meditate on a small island in front of the temple and express our innermost emotions. Then we'll take a late flight back to Cairo. Or we can spend the night in Aswan and fly next morning.* [B,L,D]

* Last night might be in Aswan or in Cairo according to flight availability during booking.

DAY 9 [OCTOBER 18]

Assisted by our representative, you'll be picked up driven to Cairo International Airport for your flight back home. [B]

If you prefer, we can add a three-day excursion to the Siwa Oasis—which we highly recommend—where you can camp in the desert and wash away any negative energy in the natural salty lakes. Siwa itinerary on following page:

DAY 10 [OCTOBER 19]

We'll drive 800 kilometers to the Siwa Oasis via Egypt's Mediterranean coast, stopping at the El Alamein cemetery and the military museum dedicated to all the countries that participated in the famous World War II battle. At Matrouh, we'll break for lunch and a view of the sea. In the afternoon, we'll drive to Fetnas Island for an amazing sunset over the Egyptian desert and some free time at the local markets before dinner at the Siwa Safari Paradise Hotel. [L,D]

DAY 11 [OCTOBER 20]

After breakfast, we will explore the oasis ruins and the local fort of Shalei, then drive to the tombs of Jabal al-Mawta ["Mountain of the Dead"]. We will then drive to the oracle temple of Alexander the Great and the remains of the ancient Egyptian temple of Amoun [Om Abide]. Later, we'll have some time at the Cleopatra Spring and the crystal clear salt lakes of Siwa. We'll navigate the sand dunes by the jeep to Bier Wahid, one of the best hot water springs in the Siwa desert. There, we'll enjoy a picnic lunch prepared by our driver. Then we'll will drive back to Siwa for an overnight stay at Siwa Safari Paradise Hotel. [B,L,D]

DAY 12 [OCTOBER 21]

After breakfast we'll head back to Cairo with a lunch stop in Matrouh.

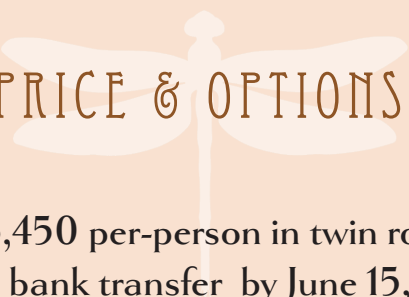




YOUR GUIDES

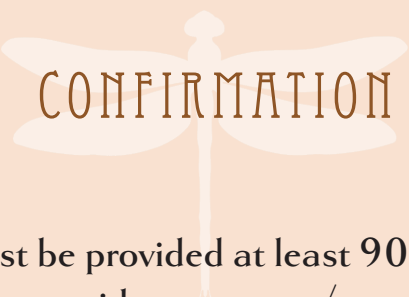

CONFIRMATION

Final confirmations must be provided at least 90 days before the start of the trip/package. Please provide passenger/group numbers and arrival and departure date when confirming booking. We will also require final names [first and last] of all travelers at this time. Failure to do so may result in the supplier being unable to fulfil all services and RMT potentially incurring extra costs for amendments.

PAYMENT TERMS:

Upon receipt of the final list of travelers, RMT will provide an invoice for payment due 30 days before the trip's departure. Any late additions or addition services booked within 75 days should not delay payment for the trip and will be invoiced separately.

CANCELLATIONS:

RMT will not charge fees for any cancelled bookings [itineraries/hotels/products] made up to 75 days before departure, except for non-recoverable deposits, such as booking deposits for pre-payments of trip services [i.e., permits, charters, special services]. Deposits will be made known to the group and need to be paid at the time of booking and are entirely non-refundable. Cancellations made within 60 to 30 days will incur a loss of 25% of the booking value. Cancellations made within 30 days will incur a 100% loss.
